RE: Lower Sixth Reports and January AS modular results

With the completion of AS unit examinations in certain subjects, your son or daughter should now be fully focused on the remainder of the AS specification in his or her four subjects. All Lower Sixth pupils will receive a full school report at the end of this term, which will summarise strengths and weaknesses as well as highlighting strategies for improvement; teachers will also give an indication both of the level at which your son or daughter is working, as well as of the grade to which he or she should be aspiring in the summer. This report should focus final preparation over the Easter holiday.

Results of the January modules (where taken) should arrive in school on **Wednesday March 10th** and they will be passed on to the pupils via Form Tutors. Should we feel it is important to discuss your son or daughter's progress (possibly in the light of these results), teachers will ask pupils to make an appointment for you between 5 and 8pm on the evening of **Monday March 15th** (already set aside for an Upper Sixth subject tutor/parents' consultation evening).
